#### **RENEWAL RECOMMENDATION:**

It is the recommendation of DCSD staff that the charter contract between Douglas County School District (DCSD) and World Compass Academy be renewed for a term of 5 years.

#### **RENEWAL APPLICATION PROCESS & EVALUATION:**

The renewal process provides an opportunity for schools to (1) present any new or supplemental evidence of school performance and (2) articulate school plans and capacities for the next charter term. The charter renewal recommendation to the Board will be based on an array of evidence gathered over the charter term, including data and information collected by Douglas County School District Office of Choice Programming, the Colorado Department of Education, and any supplemental information that the applicant group provides.

The renewal process begins in September when the charter school declares its intent to apply for renewal. No later than September 1, the charter school submits its Renewal Application to the DCSD Office of Choice Programming. All information is presented to the Superintendent's Cabinet through a compilation of evidence collected through the school's site visit, an analysis of the school's educational, operational, and financial health, and any feedback provided to the DCSD Office of Choice Programming by the applicant team upon initial review of this final report.

### **SCHOOL OVERVIEW**

**Mission:** World Compass Academy is dedicated to nurturing an inclusive environment where every student is valued, supported, and empowered to thrive. We are committed to fostering academic excellence, nurturing the growth of character, and cultivating awareness, knowledge, interest and curiosity of other cultures and geographic areas. We strive to inspire lifelong learners who are equipped with the skills, knowledge, and values to make a positive impact in our local and global communities.

**Vision:** World Compass Academy envisions a world where empowered and globally-minded citizens confidently navigate the challenges and opportunities of the future.

## **Key Design Elements:**

- Language Immersion School- Students K-1 spend 2.5 hours of their day with 90% of the class in the targeted language, Grades 2-5 spend 45 min, Grades 5-8 spend 60 minutes daily in language classes
- Second Step program and Capturing Kids' Hearts are used as a social-emotional learning curriculum in all grade levels
- Professional Learning is planned and focused based on trend data. For example, 2019 CMAS writing was a focus
  area that translated to professional learning to address
- Multiple student-led organizations, such as Cougar Committee, Sources of Strength, intellectual virtues, etc.
- Board of Directors meets annually for goal setting and review of data
- Overall Rating of EXEMPLARY by outside reviewer and successful annual reports by DCSD

#### **Information Since Last Renewal:**

- Strategic and deliberate incorporation of Belonging, Engagement, and Ownership. Results have been promising so far.
- Information sessions offered to parents dedicated to READ plans based on feedback from the community
- Reading intervention structure was changed after COVID pandemic due to Kindergarten Readiness Indicators. Students on grade level have increased greatly in early grades.

A review of the past three years shows World Compass Academy met all fiscal benchmarks set forth by Douglas County School District, showing strong fiscal health. World Compass Academy has 16 weeks of reserve fund balance, which has remained steady over the last 5 years. While reviewing the remaining benchmarks, World Compass Academy is well over the required ratio for each fiscal benchmark. World Compass Academy continues to show strong fiscal health and meets all financial deadlines.
