Enrollment Projections Overview

- Updated annually late October-December
- By school and grade for next 8 years
- Intended for capital planning and capacity analysis but also serve to inform budget and staffing decisions
- Includes:
 - PK-12 grades
 - Primary enrollment only
 - Charters including anticipated future openings

- Cohort retention model
- Backwards reconciliation
- Manual adjustments based on input data

Data Sources

- Total births
- Residential development and student generation
- In and out migration
- Housing issues
- School choice
- Charter provided estimates
- Anticipated new school openings






While overall enrollment is projected to decline we still have areas of <u>significant</u> growth and overcrowding.



Projected Enrollment - By Level












WPA: Douglas County HS Feeder Projections









EPA: Chaparral HS Feeder Projections









EPA: Ponderosa HS Feeder Projections


















Crystal Valley Elementary School and Mesa Middle School Addition









The Canyons Elementary School








Sierra Middle School Addition

Overflow Boundary System - Current Status

- Crystal Valley / Montaine into Rock Ridge, Flagstone, Castle Rock ES, Southridge
 - In year 3 of 5-year duration proceeding within enrollment parameters
- Canyons / Meridian into Timber Trail / Eagle Ridge
 - In year 3 of 5-year duration proceeding within enrollment parameters at Timber Trail.
 Meridian (and Ridgegate) enrollment will present challenges to Eagle Ridge and open enrollment destinations
- Macanta (Canyons South) into Legacy Point
 - Proceeding as planned with Leman South Campus expected to provide relief for new residents in Macanta and Looking Glass
- Sterling Ranch / Solstice to Coyote Creek
 - In year 3 of 3 year duration proceeding as planned. Mobiles will be required next year and a second overflow location should be planned and implemented no later than 2024
